 in the said tract or parcel of land or lands aforesaid to the law  
 in such case as fully and as absolutely as I myself might could  
 or ought to do in and about the premises aforesaid and  
 to employ one or more attorneys in the matter if he should  
 think proper under him to act in every respect in any  
 thing or every thing necessary to be done by virtue of

 our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty Eight
