

Tested the sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Twenty Eight at the Suit of Thomas Edwards to me directed, Commanding me, that of the good and chattels lands and tenements of Wiley Burns to levy the sum of twenty two dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Wiley Burns all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, containing one hundred acres more or less situate and lying in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid on the South side of Enore branch beginning on a Stake on Perry's line and runs as follows South to a black oak thence with Hoatts line thence South 44 degrees W to the head of the Cottail branch thence Northwardly up the hill to a hemlock thence along the Ridge to the mouth of the branch to a white oak corner thence down said branch to the beginning being a part of a tract of land granted to Robert Prince which parcel of one hundred acres of land as aforesaid unto the said Thomas Edwards, and whereas the said premises with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by Thomas Edwards of the district of Greenville for the sum of twenty five dollars & seventy five cents being the highest sum that was bid there for Now Know ye that I James McDaniel Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of twenty five dollars & seventy five cents to me in hand paid or secured to to be paid by the said Thomas Edwards the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Edwards his heirs and assigns forever the said tract, piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the Estate, right, title and interest which the said Wiley Burns of Right had, of in or to the same to Have and to Hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Thomas Edwards his heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as the said James McDaniel might, could, or ought to grant bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri Facias or other wise In witness whereof I the said James McDaniel have hereunto set my hand and seal the second day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
