 Creamer his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind
 my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and
 for ever defend all and singular the sd. premises unto the said James
 Creamer his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and
 against every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal
 this fifth day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen
 hundred and five and in the twenty ninth year of the in-
