Know all men by these presents that I Morgan Hood of Greenville District and State aforesaid for in consideration of Eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John Spriggs of this place have granted, bargained sold and release and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said John Spriggs a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the district aforesaid on both sides of the Middle Fork of Saluda River Original Granted to Thomas Brummett and Stephen Phillips Beginning at a hickory stump corner running South 45 E 22 24 to Stake & thence S 67 W 22 to a mouth of a ditch thereon the meander of the River to the mouth of the first branch thence up the branch to a white oak corner thence S 68 W to white oak & thence N 45 W 25 to point as thence
