

South Carolina To all to whom these presents shall
 come I James McDaniel Sheriff of Greenville District and State
 aforesaid send Greeting. Whereas, by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias
 issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the district
 of Greenville tested the nineteenth day of February in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine at
 the suit of William H. Salmon against John Boswell to me
 directed, commanding me that of the goods and chattels, land and
 tenements of John Boswell to levy the sum of Forty dollars damages
 and Costs, I have seized and taken of the land and tenements of
 the said John Boswell all that certain piece parcel and tract
 of land, containing Three hundred and thirty Eight acres of land
 situate and being in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid
 it being a part of a tract of land containing five hundred
 acres granted to John Nichol, situate on both sides of a
 branch of Musk Creek waters of Tyger River and runs as follows
 beginning on a white oak in a branch thence S 81. west twenty
 seven chains to a stake and pointer thence North forty seven deg
 rees west twenty one chains and fifty links, to a stake thence
 S 28. degrees west 12 chains and seventy five links, to a red oak the
 neer South 75. degrees west six chains to a Hickory thence South
 fifty seven degrees west ten chains to a Hickory thence E 16
 chains to a white oak thence South 30. degrees west 32 chains
 to a black oak thence S 70 degrees East 25 chains to a black
 oak thence South 30. degrees E. 10. 50. links, to a hickory thence
 S 21. degrees E. 31 chains to a red oak thence N 70. degrees E. 25 cha
 ins to a chestnut thence N. 24. degrees E. 6 chains to Spanish
 oak thence N. 11 degrees W. 8. chains to a sassa wood thence
 N. 7. degrees E. 12 chains to Red oak thence 88. W. 3. chains to
 a stake on a S. branch thence down said branch to the
 beginning containing three hundred and thirty Eight
 acres more or less. And whereas, the said premises, with
 their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made by virtue
 of the said writ of Fieri Facias, before mentioned, have
 been exposed at public Vendue and purchased by James
 Taylor of the said district of Greenville for the sum of
 fifteen dollars being the highest sum that was bid for

 to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue
 of the Statute in such cases made and provided and
