The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I  
Andrew Bridges of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and  
in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to me in hand  
paid by Samuel McBainell of the district and state aforesaid  
Have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant bar-  
gain sell and release unto the said Samuel McBainell all that par-  
cel of land lying in the district and state aforesaid on the head branch  
of the Broadwater Creek, and other Branches of the North fork  
of Saluda River Containing by estimation one hundred and  
fifty four acres, be the same more or less, being part of a tract  
of two hundred and sixty six acres, originally granted to Samuel  
French by grant bearing date the fifth day of June 1786 and part  
of a tract of land granted to Thomas McBainell and adjoining the  
above tract and runs as follows, that is to say Beginning on a  
Rock on Samuel French's S.E. line forty rods from his corner thence  
to a Stake on the conditional line thence with the said Samuel Mc-  
Bainells marked line to the Spring branch near his old field  
thence down the meanders of said branch to a Stake on McBainells  
line thence said McBainells line to a small poplar thence with a  
late marked line fifty rods to a small red oak thence to a straight  
a southward course one hundred and twenty eight rods to  
a red oak thence a marked line fifty rods to a wild crabapple  
tree on or near said McBainells old line thence with said old  
line to a red oak thence to the beginning. Together with all and  
singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the  
said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the  
said Samuel McBainell his heirs and assigns forever and I do  
hereby bind myself my heirs Executors, administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the above mentioned premises unto  
the said Samuel McBainell his Executors, administrators or assigns or
