State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that we Baylis J. Earle and Perry E. Duncan administrators of the Estate of the late Alexander Sloan deceased by virtue of and in pursuance of the power and authority in us vested by a decree and order of the Court of Equity for Granville District at June Term 1827; a certified Copy of which is hereunto annexed and for and in Consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to us in hand paid as such administrators as aforesaid for the benefit of said Estate the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge as assets in our hands for the payment of debts have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto Spartan Goodlett all that tract of land and plantation situate in Granville District on both sides of South Tyger River on which Allan Marshall formerly lived and sold as his property at Sheriff's sale, and purchased by the Alexander Sloan Containing as according to a late survey made by Thomas P. Hudson D.P. One hundred and sixty four acres Beginning on a white oak 3x thence N. 50 W. 24 ch 80 to a stone 3x thence S. 65 W. to ch 50 to a white Oak 3x on the River down thence due west across the River q. ch. 50 to a white Oak 3x thence S. 40 W. 26 ch 50 to a hickory 3x down thence N. 88 W. 13 ch to a Black oak 3x below a spring thence S. 34 E. 12 ch to a Hickory 3x thence S. 40 W. 14 ch to a pine Stake 3x Nelsons old corner, thence S. 21 E. one chain 65 links to a poplar 3x in the head of the said Branch; thence down and along the several meanders of the said Branch to the River and a cross the same to a cotton wood 3x opposite the mouth of the said branch, thence N. 57 E. 22 ch to the beginning white oak having such other shape buttress and boundaries as are represented in a plat thereof by the said Thomas Hudson made 14th Feb 1829. Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Spartan Goodlett his heirs and assigns for ever and we the said Baylis J. Earle and Perry E.
