 for the better securing the payment thereof I the said Elizabeth B. Lee
 do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Blackman Ligon his heirs
 and assigns for ever all that plantation, piece, parcel or tract of land
 on which the said Blackman Ligon now lives and for which the said premises
 - say notes were given a lease mentioned containing fifty acres be the same
 more or less. beginning on a Post oak running thence S 55 E 22 chgs to a white
 Oak thence S 70 E 26 chgs 75 lk. to a post oak, thence N 54 1/2 W 23. 75 to
 a red oak thence to the beginning being the same by me conveyed to the said
 Mrs Lee deed bearing even date with these presents. Together with all and
 singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belong-
 ing or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold the said
 tract piece parcel of land to the said Blackman Ligon his heirs and assigns for
 ever Provided always never the less. and it is the true intent and meaning
 of these presents that if the said Mrs Elizabeth B. Lee her heirs Executors or
 Administrators shall well and truly pay the said notes with interest a
 gratale to the time and effects of the said promissory notes then these
 presents shall be utterly null and void and it is covenanted and con-
 gned upon by and between the parties to these presents that until
 default shall be made of paying said notes it shall and may be lawfull
 for the said Mrs Elizabeth B. Lee, peaceably and quietly to hold use
 occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the said premises before men-
