Chr. 50 lk, to the beginning containing by estimation one hundred and forty three Acre but the same more or less the same being granted unto me by Patent bearing date the 5th day of April 1819. by his Excellency John Gratiot. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining To Have and To Hold the above mentioned premises unto the said George M. Logan his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby for my self my heirs warrant & defend the above mentioned premises unto the said George M. Logan his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
