 to the said Samuel Brayton and his heirs all my Right, title, Claim
 and estate of what kind soever of in and to a certain tract of land
 wherein Mrs Susannah Wynne now lives to which I am now or
 may be intitled as one of the heirs or legatus under and by the will
 of Mathew Wynne late deceased And I do hereby empower and auth-
 orize the said Samuel Brayton to demand sue for and receive all my
 portion of said Land or the proceeds of the same should it be sold and
 full and final acquittances to Execute and give when the same is need
 and the same to apply to his own proper use as fully I might or
 could have done Witness my hand and seal this 15 day
