The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that J. Henry
Bradford of St. Clair County & State of Alabama for and in consideration
of the sum of thirty five dollars to me in hand paid by Dyer Valley of Grunville
District and State of South Carolina have given granted bargained sold
and released & by these presents do give grant bargain sell and release unto
the said Dyer Valley a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being
in Grunville District South Carolina on both sides of a small branch of
the Middle fork of Saluda River including some of the branches of
big Creek or Giles Creek and is bounded as follows to wit Beginning on a black
Gum thence running S. 58. E. 72 c. to a Stake thence N. 32. E. 65. to a Stake thence N. 60.
W. 32. 75 to a white oak thence N. 21. E. 15 to a Stake thence N. 72 W. 38. 50 to a whi-
te oak thence S. 32. W. 72 to the beginning Black Gum containing in the
whole five hundred acres less the same more or less. Together with all and
singular the rights minuts hereditaments and appurtenances to the same
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
the above described premises unto the said Dyer Valley his heirs and
assigns forever and I the said Henry Bradford do hereby bind myself my
heirs Executors or Administrators firmly to warrant and for ever defend the said
premises unto the said Valley his heirs &c against myself my heirs Execs or adms and
against the just claim of every other person or persons claiming the same or any
part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 22nd January 1829. Signed sealed and acknowledged and delivered in the presence
