Jones of the State of South Carolina and District of Greenville have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Mary W. Jones her Executors administrators and assigns a negro girl Named Hannah aged about thirteen years to have and to hold the said negro girl unto her the said Mary W. Jones her Executors administrators and assigns for ever and I the said Samuel Williams for myself my heirs Executors and administrators the said negro girl unto the said Mary W. Jones her Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of me the said Samuel Williams my Executors and administrators and of every other person whosoever shall and will warrant and forever defend. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 6 July 1829.

South Carolina I know all men by these presents that I Pleasant Moon for and in consideration of two hundred dollars to me paid by Josiah Kilgore, have granted has gained, sold & released, & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Josiah Kilgore all that parcel of land containing 140 acres more or less in Greenville District on the Long Branch of Rockey Creek of Rudy River being part of a tract of land granted to James Seaborn begining at a small Sweet-gum st. on a small branch thereof said branch to a Maple st. thence on bears line N. 35. W. 4. 25 to a Stake N. 75. E. 20. 75 to a Stake on waggon road thence up said road to a Stake, thence on Mr. Read's line N. 65. W. 30. to a Sp. 0. 3x thence S. 25. W. 18 to R. 0. thence ¹¹³ in Aquilla Brasiers line S. 18. E. 40. 50 to Maple st. on branch thence S. 43. W. 18 to maple stump on Long branch thence down said branch to a lot. 0. 3x thence on Cape line N. 5. S. 2. E. 16. to the begining
