Know all men by these presents that I William Choice of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of Six hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by John H. Goodlett Esquire of Greenville District in the State aforesaid Have Granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said John H. Goodlett that parcel or Lot of land in the Village of Greenville situate on Jail Street bounded by said Street on the South by the said John H. Goodletts Lot on the west and on the North and East by Dr. John Brittenders Lot where he now lives; the said Lot containing one hundred feet front on Jail Street and fifty two and a half feet deep being the same Lot that Capt. Sumner Cleveland conveyed to me by deed dated the tenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty three and the same whereon my office now stands together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to Have and to Hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said John H. Goodlett his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind my self and my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said John H. Goodlett his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim or to claim the same or any part thereof.
