a South course to a forked Chestnut Oak thence the said course
to a Chestnut-oak thence the said course to a ~~water~~ Oak corner
on the branch thence down the branch to Black Gum & on
said River thence up the meanders of said River to the beginning
Corner with all and singular the rights and appurtenances thereto
belonging to the said premises and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Ex-
ecutors and administrators and do warrant and defend the said
premises unto the said Jeremiah Whitmire his heirs and assigns
against myself my heirs and against every other person or per-
-sons claiming the same as witnesses hereof I have set my hand
and seal this 16 day of March 1829.
