 both of the State aforesaid that the said David Terry with his present
 family shall immediately remove to the plantation where James H.
 Earle ^{deceas} lived and take into his possession the following Negroes
 Viz, Mattie, Millie, Abram, Phillis, Lester, Minor, Lolarissa, Matt,
 Jack, Peru, Anicka, Charles, Flora, Terry, Emanuel, Jacob, Tarketon
 & Jim the whole of which negroes he is to have the use of until
 the first day of January 1835 and to work such as an able on
 the plantation Exclusively & under his own direction feed the
 whole of them during the whole time plentifully cloath them
 warmly lodge them comfortably and in all respects treat-
