ty into his custody and possession and the same to hold and retain to  
his own use and behoof as his own proper goods and chattels from  
time forth and for ever, or the same to sell and dispose of at will  
and pleasure; returning the over plus if any should happen to be  
after paying the said sum of eight hundred & two dollars & thirty  
one <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Cents, interest unto the said Daniel Beacham his Executors,  
Administrators or assigns. In witness whereof I the said Daniel  
Beacham have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day  
of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-  
dred and thirty and of the Sovereignty and Independence of  
the United States of America the fifty fourth.

that I Benjamin Nelson of the District of Grunville and State  
aforesaid in Consideration of two hundred dollars to me paid by  
Samuel Campbell & Morgan Thompson of the State aforesaid  
have granted bargained sold and released unto the said S. Ca-  
mpbell & Thompson a certain tract of land containing  
one hundred and sixty two acres more or less lying on the south  
side of Pyle branch in the District and State aforesaid and  
waters of Reedy River laid out as follows begining on a  
Maple corner on Cockrels line thence west to a R. C. on  
sd. Cockrels line thence a long sd. Cockrels line to a Chestnut  
on Seaborn line thence south along sd. Seaborn line to a Stake  
corner on Thompson Dickerson line thence a long sd. J. Dick-  
son line to a pine knot corner on Pollard line thence a  
long sd. Pollard line to a black oak thence a long sd.

up said branch to the beginning together with all
