Know all men by these presents that I, John Cox of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of one hundred and thirty dollars to me in hand paid by Joshua Cox of the State and District aforesaid I have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joshua Cox all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and thirty five acres it being a part of a tract of 640 acres originally granted to Margret Cook by patent bearing date the 21st day of Jan'y 1785 and recorded in Grant book A.A.A.A page 441 situate in the State and District aforesaid on both sides of Maple Creek waters of Enore River beginning at a sawwood corner on the east side of said creek and runs up the meander of said Creek to a maple corner on the west side of said Creek thence runs on a marked line S 57. N 28. E to a stake corner on the original line thence North 28 W. to the original stake corner thence East on the original line to a stake or old made between Henry Oldham & said John Cox thence on a marked line S 39. E to the beginning sawwood corner which includes the full land to be conveyed be the same more or less Together with with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments & Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have & to Hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the only use and behoof of the said Joshua Cox his heirs & assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & admors to for ever warrant and defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joshua Cox his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs Executors & administration and na further.
