 District aforesaid HAVE this day bargained and sold and by these pres-
 ents do bargain sell and release unto James Harr a certain tract or
 parcel of Land Containing thirty acres less the same more or less
 lying on the waters of Saluda River in the district & State aforesaid
 Beginning on a poplar corner on the bank of a Creek thence up
 said Creek to a Candelianal white Oak corner made by the
 said Pritchot and Harr on the bank of said Creek thence up
 sd Creek to the mouth of a small branch on the N. side of the
 Creek thence a straight line to Martin Hunts line to a red
 Oak corner on said line this is a conditional line made by
 Pritchot and Harr to Martin Hunts line thence with Hunts
 line to a white Oak corner on the said J. Harrs line thence
 with said Harrs line to a red oak corner on the road thence
 with said Harrs line to a Sassafras corner on Harrs line
 thence with said Harrs line to the beginning poplar corner on
 on the Creek Together with all and singular the rights min-
 dments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in any wise incident or pertaining to have & to Hold all &
 singular the said premises & house mentioned unto the said James
 Harr his heirs Execs administrators and assigns for ever against
 myself my heirs Execs administrators and I do hereby bind myself my
 heirs Executors and administrators to warrant & forever defend
 all and singular the aforesaid premises unto the said
 James Harr his heirs Execs administrators and assigns for ever ag-
 ainst myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns for ever and
 against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claim-
 ing or to claim the same or any part thereof as witness where-
 afores I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
 15 December 1829.
