Lillbridge and Maria his wife of the first part of the County of Chatham and State aforesaid and Thomas G. Walker of the County of DeRivier and State of Georgia of the second part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for & in consideration of the sum of six thousand dollars to them in hand well and truly paid by the said party of the second part at or before the signing and sealing of these presents, the whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained sold aliened and conveyed, and by these presents, doth grant, bargain sell, alien and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns for ever; All those certain tracts, lots or parcels of land, situate and lying, in the village of Greenville State of South Carolina and known in the place of said Village of Greenville by the numbers seventeen, 17, eight 18, nineteen, 19, & twenty, 20, together with all and singular the rights, members appurtenances and priviledges in any wise thereunto belonging or appertaining to have & to hold the said premises and all things in any wise thereunto appertaining, to the only proper use benefit & behoof of the said party of the second part his heirs & assigns for ever. And the said party of the first part doth and by these presents will and shall forever warrant and defend the said premises unto the party aforesaid of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, against the said party of the first part his heirs Executors & Administrators, and against all and every person whomsoever in witness whereof the said party of the first part have, hereunto set their hands and seals this 24 the December 1822.
