ning corner including one hundred & thirty eight acres more or
less together with all and singular the rights members and apperten-
ances to the same belonging, or in any wise incident DO HAVE AND TO
HOLD to the said Nathl L. Dobynes his heirs and assigns for ever and
lastly I the said John Townsend doth hereby warrant & for ever
defend the aforesaid land and premises to the said Nathl L. Dobynes his
heirs and assigns for ever from myself my heirs and assigns and from
all other persons claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness
