McGregor the above premises together with all the improvements
thereon is to be long to the said J H Goodell or to go back into his
estate to be disposed of as his other estate and this instrument to
be null and void to all intents and purposes. And during her natural
lifetime I do warrant and defend the said premises unto the
said Mrs A. Pelle McGregor to be and remain in her quiet and peace-
able possession only not to be leased or this deed of trust to be trans-
ferred in any manner so as to put the possession of the said pre-
mises in the hands or power or possession of any other person
or persons whatsoever but solely for her use and benefit during
her lifetime and those of her children who may live with her

and granted sold and released and by these presents do bargain grant
sell and release unto the said David Shockley a parcel or tract of
land laying in the state and district aforesaid on the waters of little
Horse Creek waters of Rudy River beginning on a black gum 3x
on a small branch thence 183 E 15 to a hickory 3x thence N 22 E 150
to a pine 3x bounded by my own land thence S 68 E 11¹⁶⁸ to a stake 3x
thence S 30 E 12 to a post oak bounded by lands belonging to William
Means thence South 01 W 38 50 to a Dogwood 3x thence N 60 W 25
to a maple 3x on a branch thence up the meanders of
said branch to the beginning bounded on Hudson Burys.
