

Hays Pyatt, and upon the delivery thereof to them have received from another negro slave named Winney in place and lieu of the said negro girl Rosina which we covenant promise and agree for our selves our heirs and assigns to hold in trust for the said William Moulden and his wife in the same manner and for the same purpose prescribed by the original deed of trust to us to which reference is hereby made which is declared a part of this deed -

Know all men by these presents that I Greenville District Densley Nesbitt of the State and district aforesaid in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to me paid by William Nesbitt of the said State and District aforesaid HAVE Granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said William Nesbitt the plantation and tract of land where he now lives being part of a tract of land originally granted to James Jordan for three hundred acres recorded in grant Book 333 page 55 on the 16th of July 1784 and lying in the State and district aforesaid on the waters of Rudy River beginning at a black Oak or Stake ³⁷ the original corner thence running south 56 bounded by William Choice land to a Stake thence East 43 bounded by Mr G. Gunnell to a Stake at the Creek thence up the meanders of said Creek to a Stake on the original line bounded by the said Densley Nesbitt thence West 13 to the beginning containing one hundred and sixty two acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said William Nesbitt his heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Nesbitt his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this twenty first day of April in the year ¹⁸¹ of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty and in the fifty fourth year of the Independence of the United States of America
