Barnwell in trust for Catharine Barnwell all that Lot or parcel of Land in the Village of Greenville in the State aforesaid in the N. E. square measuring one hundred and fifty feet front on McBee Street and three hundred feet on Coffee Street Bounded on the South by Coffee Street - on the W. by McBee Street on the N. by Lot No. 38 and on the E. by said said Lot being known as No. 39 in the grand plan of the said village reference thereto as also to the plat hereto annexed will more fully and at large appear together with all and singular the rights, number, boundaries and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid mentioned unto the said John N. Barnwell in trust for the said Catharine her heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and aditors to warrant to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises aforesaid mentioned unto the said John for the special use and intent of the said Catharine her heirs and assigns for ever against myself my heirs and all other persons claiming or to claim the same of, by, from or under me.
