 Greenville District } as Stone of the State and District aforesaid
 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to
 me in hand paid by Benjamin Stone of the State and district
 aforesaid have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents
 do bargain sell and convey unto Benjamin Stone a certain
 tract of land containing one hundred and seventy acres
 more or less on the north side of the south fork of Saluda
 River beginning on Joseph Corner a Spruce pine at the
 mouth of the bearing tract from thence along Hardins
 line to his corner white oak from thence a long a line of mark
 trees nearly a north course to line of said grant granted to Thomas
 Blyth from thence along the line of said grant to hunters
 line to the River from thence up the River to the beginning.
 To have and to hold all the aforesaid premise unto the aforesaid
 B. Stone whereas I bind my self my heirs and assigns to war-
 ant and defend the land from any other person or persons
 just right or claim unto Benjamin Stone his heirs and
 assigns forever. Given under my hand this twenty third
 day of October one thousand Eight hundred and twenty
