State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John Greenwell District J. Smith of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Sims Smith of the same place, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Sims Smith all that plantation or tract of land containing Eighty two acres and a half, more or less, originally granted to Honor Bishop of bearing date fifth day of June 1786. lying and being in the State and District aforesaid on the South Pedy fork waters of Pedy River beginning on State 3⁺ thence S. 30 W. to red oak thence S. 60 E. to black 3⁺ then by a conditional line between Daniel Ford and Honor Bishop to a shell pasture here 3⁺ then up the branch to a white oak Nation thence to the beginning. Conveyed from said Bishop to Charles Crawford and from said Crawford to John F. Wolff and from said Wolff to John Smith and recd from said Smith to said Sims Smith. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinences belonging or any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Sims Smith his heirs Executors and administrators forever by these presents to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises as before, against my self my heirs executors and administrators or assigns and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
