388 State of South Carolina I Know all men by these presents that I Stephen Greenville District 3 Dill of the State and District aforesaid do for the great love and affection which I bear my son Joseph Dill do give, grant, and bequeath and by these presents do give bequeath and convey unto my dearly beloved Son Joseph Dill a certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the State and District aforesaid on a branch called Martenbergs Beaverdam it being a part of a tract of land granted to Stephen Dill by John Dill wherein the said Joseph Dill now lives bounded as follows on the west by the Greenville road North by lands of John Cochran East by lands of Thomas Divine & south by land granted to Stephen Dill now conveyed to William Dill as referred to the plat of this said tract. Together with all, and singular the rights immunities hereditaments & appurtenances to the said parcel or tract of land by the same more or less to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph Dill his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto my son Joseph Dill, his heirs and assigns for ever against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons whomever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third day of August one thousand eight hundred and nineteen signed, sealed & delivered in presence of us Wm Boston, Elijah Dill 3 Stephen Dill P.S. mark
