This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty by and between George M. Logan of the ~~one part and Alexander Canuth of~~ State of South Carolina and District Greenville of the one part and Alexander Canuth of the county of Rutherford and State of North Carolina of the other part Witnesseth that I the said George M. Logan for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars to me in hand paid Alexander Canuth the receipt and payment whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained, sold, granted and conveyed, and by these presents do bargain sell, grant and convey to the said Alexander Canuth a certain tract piece or parcel of land lying situate and being partly in the county of Rutherford and State of North
