together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and
appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before
mentioned, unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns
forever. And I do hereby bind my self, heirs, Executors and administra-
tors, to warrant, and forever defend, all and singular the said premises
unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns, against my
self, heirs and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and
seal this first day of November in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred and thirty, and in the fifty fifth year
of the Independence of the United States of America.

The State of South Carolina Do wit. Whereas my father by his last
Greenville District will and Testament directed that a
Negro boy called Abram should work with my brother Jesse Goodlett
until his youngest child should come of age and then to return to
me: And whereas I well know that my father never intended that
I should own and enjoy the labour of the said boy Abram and
in order that he may assist in providing for my brother Jesse's fam-
ily I hereby relinquish all my right title and interest in and to the
said boy Abram, and hereby agree that he shall remain with Jesse
Goodlett during his life and after his death to belong to his widow
and all their children then living except David J. Goodlett
jointly the said boy is not to be sold by the said Jesse or any of
his family during his or his wife's life, but to remain to assist the
family and after the death of the said Jesse and wife he is to be
the joint property of their children, as before stated. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3rd day of
