

Six thousand to me paid by Edmond Waddill of the District and State aforesaid HAVE granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Edmond Waddill all those several tracts or parcels of land herein after described Howit and tract containing twenty acres more or less originally granted to Baylis Earle the seventeenth day of May one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven situate lying and being in the District aforesaid on the waters of Rudy River begining on a post-oak corner running thence S. 75. W. 11. chs. 50 links to a red oak thence S. 32. E. 21. 50. to a stake thence N. 80. W. 34. chs. to a pine thence N. 20. W. 25 to a stake thence S. 76. E. 44. chs. to the begining being bounded at the time of Survey on the S. E. & W. by Jas. Whitners land. S. E. by Jas Blasingame N. W. by Baylis Earle and vacant land also one other tract or parcel of land adjoining the above containing two hundred acres more or less originally granted to the said Baylis Earle the sixteenth day of July seventeen hundred and eighty four and conveyed with the first mentioned tract from the said Baylis Earle to John Earle and from John Earle to Waddy Thompson and from Thompson to me begining on a stake corner on the S. W. bank of Rudy River running thence N. 76 W. to pine corner thence N. 14 E. to Rudy River thence down the meanders of said River to the begining to exclude all that part of the original survey of said B. Earle which lies on the S. W. side of said River. Also one other tract or parcel of land adjoining the above containing fifty acres more or less being part of a tract of land originally granted to Frederick Hawkins and conveyed to Waddy Thompson by Jas Blasingame and from said Thompson to me begining at a stake on the S. W. side of Rudy River running thence S. 22 W. to a red oak corner thence S. 68. E. 63. chains and 50 links to a stake thence N. 22 E. to the River thence up the meanders of the River to the begining. Also one other tract or parcel of land adjoining the above mentioned containing six hundred acres lie the same more or less begining on a post-oak corner on J. Earle line running thence N. 68. W. 31. chains 50 links to a red oak on McClanahan line thence S. 60. W. 45. chains 50 links to a black gum near the fork of a branch thence up the left hand fork of said branch with the meander to the second fork thence up the middle fork of said branch to a Spanish oak at or near the head thence S. 51. W. 16. chains and 70 links to a small chestnut on John Robinsons line thence with said line S. 45. E. 25 chains & 50 links to a pine knot by three post oaks thence S. 45. W. said Robinsons line 48. 8. 50 links to a stake on the out-line of said tract thence S. 45. E. 51. chains & 50 links to a post oak corner thence N. 45. E. 24 chains and 60 links to a stake near a branch thence N. 31. E. 36 chains & 50 links to a stake on Smith line thence S. 70.
