 Grayton his Executors and Administrators, to warrant and for ever  
 defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said James McDaniel  
 his heirs and assigns against themselves and against every person  
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part  
 thereof. Witness our hands and seal, this twenty eighth day of January  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty  
 one and in the fifty fifth year of the Independence of the
