Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph McCullough his heirs and assigns forever. and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph McCullough his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
