Logan of Greenville District for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars unto me paid by James L. & William Foster, sons of Milt Foster of the District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and do by these presents grant bargain sell and release unto the said James L. & William Foster a certain tract or plantation of land lying and being in the District aforesaid on the waters of Vaughn's Creek a branch of N. Pacotat River beginning at a Chestnut tree No. 67 Chs to a Black Oak tree No. 61 E 51 Chs 50 lots to a Chestnut tree No. 69 E. 24 Chs to a Stake tree No. 23 Chs to a Rock called the Cherokee corner tree Nut. 66 Chs 50 lots to the beginning containing by estimation One hundred and forty three acres more or less the same being granted unto Elizabeth Martindale by patent bearing date 5th day of April 1819 by his Excellency John C. Calhoun and from her the said Martindale unto me together with all and singular the rights, moneys, benefits and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the above mentioned premises unto the said James L. & William Foster their heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs warrant and defend the above mentioned premises unto the said James L. & William Foster their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the first day of April A.D. One thousand eight hundred and thirty and six years of America Independent
