 which Thomas Barton lived and died and by his heirs conveyed to the  
 said Wheaton Merritt by deed dated 22 Decr 1823. Beginning on Wilsons  
 Bartons line on the Creek, thence on Tho. Bartons gr line up the Creek to Jose  
 -ph Bartons line thence westwardly on the old line agreeably to the grant  
 to Wm Barton thence round with the several grants to the beginning bound-  
 ed on the several sides by the lands of Tho. Bartons Austin Allmand Geo Under-  
 woods and Wilson Barton. See the deed referred to. Together with all and singular  
 the hereditaments rights, members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said  
 tract of land belonging, or in any wise appertaining; and the reversions and  
 remainders rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate right-title  
 interest, power, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever  
 both at law and in Equity, of the heirs and representatives of the said
