Jeremiah Cleveland all that part or tract of Land Lying on the Middle Fork
of Saluda River Containing two acres more or less being part of a tract of
land Originally granted to my Father Daniel Mesunkin Beginning on a Rock
On the East Bank of the River opposite the Land described by Daniel and
George Mesunkin to Jeremiah Cleveland and running thence a northerly
Easterly direction to a Stake on the East Bank of the river a bent sever-
Chain thence down the River as it meanders to the Beginning Birch coming
together with all and singular the Rights, members, Hereditaments, and appurte-
nances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining
thereto and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my
self, heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant, and forever defend, all and singular the
said premises, unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns; against myself and
against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part
