Granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary E. Stone all that tract
piece or parcel of land situate in the District first aforesaid
on the North Fork of Richland Creek of Rudy River con-
taining One hundred and fifty seven acres, it being part of a
tract of land originally granted to Samuel J. Alston and conveyed
by the said Alston to John Watson sen^r and the part herein convey-
ed was conveyed by the said John Watson sen^r to the aforesaid John
Watson the said Land has such marker bounds &c as follows, viz,
beginning at a red oak 3^t on the old Spartanburgh Road thence S. 29° E
16.25 chs to a N. 0^t 3^x at the head of a branch thence down said branch
10 chs to a Stake 3^t thence N. 45° E 2.25 chs to a hickory 3^x thence S. 30° E 16.50 to
a Stake on the original line of said Land thence on said line N. 65° E 3
