



by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said William
Cunningham all that plantation or tract of Land situated in Gre-
enville district aforesaid on Thompsons Beaverdam waters of Tyger
River granted to John Clement the 15th October 1784. and sold as his
property at Sheriff's sale and purchased by the said J. Cleveland. Conta-
ining by resurvey seven hundred and six acres be the same more
or less and having figured lines & courses and such cuttings and
boundings as are represented in a plat thereof annexed to the original
grant reference being thereunto had. Together with all and singular the
Rights, members, hindelaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belong-
ing or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold

all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
William Cunningham his heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby
bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators, to warrant and for
ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
William Cunningham his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs
and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof except and it is so understood that
this warranty does not extend to or embrace so much of ^{the} said tract as
may be covered by a tract of David Masteller the portion supposed to be
covered by Mastellers claim being represented on the plat of resurvey.
