

-ined damage and be compelled to pay out money on the said bond as security when it shall be lawful for him to foreclose this mortgage upon the said slaves or any one or more of them and sell to an amount sufficient to reimburse him all such sum or sums costs and charges as he may have been compelled to pay by reason of his securityship aforesaid and the proceeds to apply to his own use and return the excess if any to the said Vincent his heirs and assigns &c or further agreed that if it should so happen that the said James Cawes shall not have to pay any part of said Bond or any costs and charges in consequence thereof and in no wise sustain damage then and in that case the said slaves each and every one of them and their increase are of right to belong to the said Vincent as fully to all intents and purposes as if this mortgage had never been Executed. Duncan of the District and State aforesaid, in consideration of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, all my aforesaid House hold and Kitchen furniture, all my interest in the stock and trade in my said saddlers shop, two Milch Cows, twenty head of Hogs, and One Bay Horse with all and singular the increase of the said property by it by natural or other causes together with all the rents, profits, issues proceeds emoluments, interests and advantages of what nature or kind soever the same may be. To have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid property unto the said Perry E. Duncan and his heirs forever in trust never the less for the exclusive use benefit enjym
