 whatsoever my design in this Settlement being to provide a sure and
 safe home for a Widow and her orphan Children, whose support
 and maintenance is the sole object of this endeavor on my part to make
 this provision for that end - the design being and the same is hereby
 -ord, that my said Daughter Mary Ann Caroline Hay and her said
 Children untill the youngest Son Marian arrives to the age of two
 and one year, may at all times reside on said place and enjoy the profits
 -sing from the Cultivation of the said Land. and I do positive
 forbid the interference of any Court of Equity to alter or move
 this arrangement - the offspring of parental solicitude for the support
 of these whose happiness and independence I hold dear and
 therefore declare all such officious unauthorized and illegal attempts
 Null and Void as being contrary to law and the rights of the
 Owners of property to do as they may choose in the disposition thereof
 And I solemnly appeal to the sound discretion of those who may be im-
 -ted with the Jurisdiction of the Court of Equity in this State, to say
 they can consist with law or justice, defeat or attempt to defeat
 the laudable design of this small provision made for helpless innocents
 I have only to add my request to James L. Pellicque Esquire, Waddy D.
 -pson Esquire, Thomas S. Grimkie Esquire and Richard Allen Gantt Esquire
 Attornies at Law, that they will lend their aid at the request of my
 daughter and Children or any of them to effect the purpose and
 design of this Settlement, made for my said daughter Mary Ann
 and her Children, Intestermany whereof I have herunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this first day of July one thousand Eight hundred
 and thirty one signed sealed and delivered in presence
