And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W. Taylor his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this ninth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty one and in the fifty fifth year of the Sovereignty and independence of the United States of America Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of
