any parts thereof in witness whereof I have here unto  
set my hand & seal This 20 of Jan: 1831 Signed and Sealed

bargain sell and release unto the said John S. Fields all  
that tract or parcel of Land Situate in the district of  
Greenville in the State aforesaid on the waters of  
Rocky Creek of Enow Laurel Creek of Rudy run  
containing Sixty Two acres more or less it being part  
of a tract of Land originally Granted to the Conner
