

South Carolina: I know all men by these presents that J. Josiah Green of Greenville District for & in consideration of five hundred dollars to me paid have granted, bargained, sold & released & by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto Nancy Smith of said State & district, all that tract or parcel of land containing 425 acres more or less, being part of a tract of 740 acres granted to Stephan Howard 6th of Feby. 1804 situate in said State & district on Horsepin, a fork of Gilders Creek of Enoree River: Beginning at a stake in field & runs with Dutherty's line S: 80 W: 9.52 to P: 0.34 gone: thence with Saml. Baldwins lines S: 36 W: 13.30 to a sweet gum 34 down S: 48 1/2 E: 61.00 to P: 0.34 gone then on W^m McClellan's & W^m Goldsmith's lines N: 30. E: 54 to B: jack 34 down. then on John Green's lines N: 20 W: 68.50 to stone corner N: 45 W: 15.50 to stake: then on Thomas E. Cravys line S: 25 W: 25 to a crooked P: 0.34 34: then on W^m Goldsmith's lines S: 12 E: 20 to stake in old road S: 65 W: 34 to the beginning: Together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Nancy Smith her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Nancy Smith her heirs and assigns - against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof: Witness my hand & seal this 9th day of April 1831: - signed, sealed & acknowledged in presence of,
