

Carolina ³ I know all men by these presents that I George Bradley Greenville District ³ of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of ten Dollars to me in hand paid by Reuben Martin of the - District & State aforesaid have granted Bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, Bargain, sell and release unto the said Reuben Martin a certain parcel or part of tract of land containing ten acres be the same more or less lying in the District of Greenville. Beginning on a peach tree on George Evans line in an old field, thence near North course to a stake corner thence North 54° W. 3. 67 to a red oak corner on Isaac West line thence with said Bradleys original line to Geo. Evans line to a red oak corner. thence with said Evans line to the beginning corner together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances to the s^t. premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Reuben Martin his heirs & assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Reuben Martin his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof as witness my hand and seal this 7th December 1822. signed, sealed & delivered in presence of Joseph Turner, Moses Pritchett ³

James Powell of Lawrence Greenville District ³ District in consideration of one hundred & twenty five Dollars to me in hand paid by Lion Gambling of Greenville District have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Lion Gambling part of tract of land in Greenville District on both sides of Gilders creek beginning at Deverit Yeargains corner on the south bank of Gilders creek and running N. 8 W. 35. 12 to a white oak $\times 3$ thence down the various courses of said creek to a stake $\times 3$ thence N. 55 E. 2. 50 to a black oak $\times 3$ thence S. 20 E. 12. 50 to a pine $\times 3$ thence S. 8 E. 35 to a Spanish oak $\times 3$ S. 82. W. 13. 30 to the beginning including also all the land that was granted to said James Powell on the North side of Gilders creek it being all that land that was reserved by said Powell for a mill seat including one hundred and twenty five acres more or less on both sides of said creek. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the same before mentioned unto the said Lion Gambling and his heirs & assigns I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
