 Greenville District -- I James Bennie of the District and State
 aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty dollars to me
 in hand paid by William Jacobs of the same place have granted
 bargained, sold and released and do by these presents grant, bargain sell
 and release unto the said William Jacobs a certain piece parcel or
 tract of land situate in the District and state aforesaid on the Au-
 gustia Road two miles and a half below Greenville Court House and
 branches of Brushy Creek waters of River. Bounded on the N. by Bar-
 dry McBees land on the S. W. Jacobs land and on the W. by St. Gor-
 dans land and having such form and marks as a plat annexed
 to a grant made to James Bennie bearing date the 2^d February A.D. 1829
 a reference thereto will more fully shew. containing one hundred
 acres. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises
 unto the said William Jacobs his heirs and assigns from me and
 my heirs and no further. In witness whereof I have hereunto
