Means, have given and hereby do give to my said daughter during her natural life the following, to wit Letty & her two children, Randal & Betsy also William - Lucinda, Willis, Warren & Louisa a child of my negro woman Louisa, and at the death of my said daughter I give the aforesaid negroes with their increase to such child or children as my said daughter may leave living at the time of her death, but if she should leave no child or children living at the time of her death then in that case I give the said negroes to my two youngest children Thomas & Cornelius them and their increase, to be equally divided between them In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand seal this 10th day of Jan. 1832.
