Personally came before me the subscribing Justice John McLanahan and being duly sworn saith on said oath that he was well acquainted with Priscilla Timbers and that the said Priscilla had lived with him the said John in the State of Virginia and that a free white woman by the name of Sarah Timbers lived with him at the same time and that the said Sarah Timbers claimed the said Priscilla as her own daughter and that no person had ever doubted the same to his knowledge and that David Burdin, Thomas Burdin, Lewis Burdin, James Burdin and John Burdin were claimed by the said Priscilla to be children begotten of her own body. State of South Carolina. To all to whom these presents shall come I James McDaniel Esqr. Sheriff of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid send greeting whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville to wit the Eighteenth day of July one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one at the suit of John Moore to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels Lands and Tenements of Asa Cornett to levy the sum of forty one dollars and ninety one cents with Interest and costs. I have seized and taken of the lands and Tenements of the said Asa Cornett all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the waters of Enoree River it being part of a tract of Land granted to Young Griffin and conveyed by deed to Elliott Clardy Beginning on a red Oak corner on Andersons old line thence Running S. 15 West to a stake corner on the Hawkins line thence a conditional line made by Hawkins and myself to a chestnut corner on the old original line thence N. 60 E. to Andersons old line thence W. 37 chains to the Beginning Red oak corner Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appertainances unto the above described premises, and whereas the said premises with their appertainances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned
