Branch 14 chs to a white oak 3x in the forks of the Branch thence up the N. W. Branch with the courses of the water 35.50 to the Maple to the Beginning Bounded by Nicholas Whites land to include one hundred and sixty five acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises Belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenances unto the said William Jones his heirs and assigns forever against my self and my heirs and assigns, and I do hereby bind my self and my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend the same from the lawful claim of all persons whomsoever or any part thereof as witness my hand and seal this January 20th 1832
