Sheriff of Greenville District in the State aforesaid send
Greeting Whereas by virtue of a writ of fierificias I issued
out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the district of
Greenville tested the Eleventh day of February one thou-
sand eight hundred and Twenty Eight at the suit of
Edward Croft to me directed commanding me that of
the Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements of John H
Goodlett Esqr to Levy the sum of one thousand dollars
Damages and Costs I have seized and taken of the
Lands and Tenements of the said John H Goodlett
Esqr all that certain piece parcel and tract of land
containing Two hundred acres be the same more or
less situate Lying and being in the district and state
on the Waters of Reedy River Beginning on a corner
corner & Running thence 44 E 95 Chains to a stake & thence
Running S. 34 W 27 Chains to a red oak John Blapin game
corner thence with Blapin game's line N 32 W 20 Chains
and fifty links to a Red oak corner thence N 32 W
with Blapin game's line 70 chains 90 links to a post or
corner near the head of the Branch thence to the beginning
