Land containing four hundred and forty acres granted to William  
Steel of charlston and from him to John Steel from him to Nicholas  
Whight and from him to Edward Howard and from him to George  
Lyon Recorded in Grant Book EEEE Page 339 Situate in dis  
trict and state aforesaid on the Waters of Durbins Creek waters  
of Enoree River Beginning on a stake 3<sup>X</sup> S<sup>O</sup> 70 E 47 chains 50 links  
bounded by Edward Howard Land to a maple corner on the creek  
thence down said creek to an ash thence N 80. W 4 chains to Red  
oak thence N 12 E 40 chains to a stake thence S<sup>O</sup> 54 W 27 chains  
50 links to beginning to include one hundred and Twenty acres more  
or less and the other parcel being a part of a certain tract contain  
ning five hundred acres of Land situate in District and state  
aforesaid on the Branches of Durbin Creek Waters of Enoree River  
Granted to John Howard <sup>Sur</sup> March 7<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1796 and Conveyed  
to Edward Howard from Edward Esq<sup>r</sup> to George Lyon containing  
Two hundred and Eight acres Bounding and bounding as follow  
Viz Beginning in a white oak 3<sup>X</sup> running N 70 W 30 chains to  
Red oak 3<sup>X</sup> bounded by the above parcel of Land thence S 30  
W 40 chains to a stake 3<sup>X</sup> thence S 26 E 40 chains to pine stake 3<sup>X</sup>  
thence S 71 E 13 chains to Stake 3<sup>X</sup> thence N 11 E 43 chains 50 links  
to Sowwood on the Bank of the Creek thence down said creek  
with various courses of the Water to the Beginning to include  
Two hundred and Eight acres of Land be the same more or less the  
two parcels to contain three hundred and thirty three acres as a  
foresaid together with all and singular the premises Rights Re  
mainders Hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any  
wise Incident appertaining to have and to hold all and singular  
the premises before mentioned unto the said George Bowen and  
David Henning their heirs and assigns forever and I George  
Lyon do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors or Administrators  
to warrant and forever defend the premises above mentioned unto

lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
