2564 This Indenture made this Eighteenth January in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and Twenty six between Wm  
Justice of the State of South Carolina and district of Greenville  
of the one part and Hiram Whitted of the State of North Carolina  
and County of Buncombe of the other part witnesseth as follows  
that in consideration of the sum of four hundred and  
sixty three dollars to me the said Justice in hand paid by the sd  
Whitted the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged doth  
grant Bargain Sell and deliver unto the said Hiram Whitted  
his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land whereon  
William Word now lives lying and being on both sides of Middle  
fork of Fall Creek of the North fork of Saludia River bounded by  
lands entered by John Elledge begining at a hickory w 41 poles to a  
Chesnut 6 poles to a stake N E 1/4 poles to a stake S 80 40 poles to the  
beginning containing one hundred acres more or less also another tract  
containing fifty acres more or less begining at a white oak from  
thence north to a Beach thence to a conditional line made  
between John Heatherley and John Morgan from thence to the  
beginning also another tract containing two hundred and fifty  
acres more or less including the whole of the Lankford tract to  
gether with all of its woods ways waters mines minerals and  
appertinances to all the above mentioned lands unto the said  
Hiram Whitted his heirs air and assigns against myself myself  
heirs and assigns and against the lawfull claim or claims
