of the district and State aforesaid have granted Bargained Sold and
Released and by these presents do grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the
Said Jeremiah Cleveland all that tract or parcell of Land containing one
hundred and forty acres be the same more or less being part of a tract of Land
originally granted to James West Situate on the Needy fork beginning on a
Cherry tree a conditional corner and running a northerly course to a
pine tree William Cockrums corner at the upper side of an old pond thence
N 17 E to a stake thence S 73 E 24 chains 50 links to a stake thence S 20 E 25
chains on Gilllands line thence S 32 W 50 chains to the begining Cherry tree
it being the same land conveyed me by my father Hezekiah Cochrum on the
19th day of August 1820 and found on Clerks Record Book L pages 247 and
248 together with all and singular the rights members heredeterminments
and appertaining to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
or pertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the Said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself heirs Executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Said
Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns against myself heirs and
against every person whomever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this fourth day of
April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty
two and in the fifty sixth year of the Independence of the united
States of America
